



MARKET COMMENTARY

The **DCI** dipped by 0.28% to close the week at 7913.69 points. The **FCI** was flat at 1572.08 points.

RDCP ticked up by 2 thebe to close at 223 thebe. **Turnstar** and **Seedco** shed 5 thebe and 30 thebe to end the week at 297 thebe and 550 thebe respectively. Turnover amounted to a colossal **BWP463,395,471** as **30,049,650** shares traded. **Sechaba's** share repurchase of 16.839% of its issued shares from AB InBev Africa accounted for 92% of the week's turnover.

ECONOMIC NEWS

Inflation increases to 3.6 percent in October – Headline inflation increased to 3.6 percent from 2.9 percent in September. According to the latest data from Statistics Botswana, inflation increased for: *alcoholic beverages and tobacco* (from 0.8 to 1.1 percent); *housing, water, electricity, gas and other fuels* (from 3.4 to 3.5 percent); *and transport* (from 7.3 to 11 percent - largely because of an increase in the rate of price increase for operation of personal transport due to the rise in retail pump price for petrol and diesel). However, this was partly offset by inflation easing with respect to: *food and non-alcoholic beverages* (from -0.9 to -1.1 percent; *clothing and footwear* (from 1.6 to 1.4 percent); *furnishing, household equipment and routine maintenance* (from 2.2 to 2 percent); *recreation and culture* (from 1.9 to 1.5 percent); *restaurants and hotels* (from 3.4 to 3.2 percent); and *miscellaneous goods and services* (from 7.4 to 6.8 percent). Inflation remained unchanged for: *health* (1 percent); *communication* (-9.1 percent); and *education* (5.4 percent). The trimmed mean measure of core inflation increased from 2.9 to 3.7 percent, while inflation excluding administered prices remained unchanged at 1.6 percent.

Sechaba Announcement of Completion of Transaction in respect of the Sale of 10.1% of the Issued Shares in Kgalagadi Breweries (Pty) Ltd ("KBL") and Beverage Manufacturers Botswana (Pty) Ltd and the Repurchase of the Company of 22,398,106 Shares being 16.839% of its own Shares and Partial Delisting

Further to the Announcements of the Results of the Extraordinary General Meeting of the 27 September 2018 ("the EGM"), the Company has advised that:

- (1) the approval of the Botswana Competition Authority to the Transaction as detailed in the Circular to Shareholders dated 3 August 2018, has been obtained;
- (2) the acquisition from the Company by ABInBev Africa of 10.1% of the issued shares in each of KBL and Beverage Manufacturers (Botswana) (Pty) Ltd and the receipt as consideration thereof by the Company, by way of a share repurchase, of 22,398,016 shares representing 16.839% of the issued shares of the Company ("the Consideration Shares"), as unanimously approved by shareholders at the EGM was transacted on the BSE on 15 November 2018;
- (3) the Consideration is to be settled on 16 November 2018;
- (4) the Consideration Shares are to be cancelled.

The Botswana Stock Exchange has granted permission for the Consideration Shares (being 22,398,016 shares issued by the Company) to be delisted after settlement which is anticipated to be 16 November 2018.

Minergy Error and Correction in 2018 Integrated Annual Report Shareholder Analysis Table

Shareholders have been advised that a correction has been made to the Shareholder Analysis table contained on page 45 of the Minergy Integrated Annual Report 2018. The previous table incorrectly indicated that individual shareholders amounted to negative 26,996,558 and equated to negative 6.65%. This has been corrected to reflect that individual shareholders, of which there are 415, hold 1,719,549 and this equates to 0.42%. This information is contained in the Public/Non-Public Shareholders table where the total public shareholding equates to 36.57% made up of 432 shareholders.
