

NEW P10 BANKNOTE IN CIRCULATION

A new polymer version of the P10 banknote is entering circulation. The design is similar to the paper version of the banknote but there are some differences and it is important that the public knows what to look for to check authenticity of the new banknotes. The old banknotes will not be withdrawn from circulation and shall run parallel with the new banknotes.




GET TO KNOW YOUR NEW BANKNOTE

FEEL:



The new banknote is made of polymer, which feels smoother than the paper banknotes




A pattern of six raised dots to aid the visually impaired can be felt when running your fingers over the edge of the note

LOOK: WHEN THE BANKNOTE IS HELD UP TO THE LIGHT, THE FOLLOWING FEATURES CAN BE SEEN



A clear window with the rampant Zebra from the Bank's crest. This can be seen from both sides of the banknote



In the shield beside the Zebra, the number 10 appears

TILT:



There are shiny stripes of golden iridescent ink down the middle of the banknote showing a diamond. This appears and disappears as the banknote is tilted
