

MARKET COMMENTARY

The **DCI** saw minor gains of 0.01% to close the week at 8909.09 points. The **FCI** shed 0.10% to close at 1574.15 points. Turnover for the week amounted to **BWP45,770,345** off a volume of **11,497,839** shares traded, with newly listed CA Sales and Sechaba accounting for the bulk of turnover.

Furnmart, BTCL, and **Barclays** were the big winners for the week, ticking up by 2 thebe, 3 thebe, and 10 thebe to close the week at 55 thebe, 155 thebe, and 610 thebe respectively. Major losers included **RDCP, Letlole,** and **Sechaba,** which shed 3 thebe, 3 thebe, and 50 thebe to close at 265 thebe, 230 thebe, and 1950 thebe respectively. Despite the large volumes traded from newly listed CA Sales, the counter did not record a price change and closed the week flat.
