

Turnover for the week amounted to BWP55,132,751 off of 19,220,295 shares.

#### **CA Sales Change Statement**

With regards to the audited results for the year ended 31 December 2017, shareholders have been advised that the annual financial statements were distributed to shareholders today, 25 May 2018 and contain no modification to the audited results which were published on X-News and the 4AX Portal on 23 March 2018, apart from the following: Revenue and cost of sales for the group were both understated by R122.6 million as a result of incorrect currency translation rates used. Revenue for the group has been adjusted upward to R4 838.5 million and cost of sales upward to R4 114.9 million. Consequently, the growth in revenue for the year ended 31 December 2017 is 20%. This is an increase of 3% on the previously reported growth of 17%. These adjustments have no further impact on the statement of comprehensive income.
