COUNTERFEIT P100 AND P200 BANKNOTES IN

CIRCULATION

The public is hereby alerted of the existence of P100 and P200

counterfeits in circulation. The counterfeits are copies of a genuine P100

banknote bearing serial number AC1211512 and P200 banknotes bearing

serial numbers AB2795795 and AB4992387. Both the holographic stripe

and the windowed security thread appear as dark patches on the front

and back of the counterfeits. Furthermore, the counterfeits are made of

ordinary commercial paper, and therefore, have a smooth surface when

compared to genuine banknotes.

The public is urged to be vigilant and exercise caution when accepting

banknotes from any source, and should closely examine its security

features. Any suspicious banknotes discovered should immediately, be

reported to the nearest Police station or Bank of Botswana offices in

Gaborone or Francistown.
