DEADLINE TO EXCHANGE P1, P2 AND P5 BANKNOTES - JUNE 30, 2011

The public is reminded that as advised in the Botswana Government Gazette Volume XLIV. No.23 dated March 24, 2006, the P1, P2 and P5 banknotes ceased to be legal tender as from July 1, 2006. The remaining banknotes held by members of the public shall continue to be exchanged at the Bank of Botswana until **June 30, 2011.**

Members of the public who still have these banknotes, and wish to exchange them, will be paid the face value of the banknote(s) when these are presented at the Bank of Botswana banking halls in Gaborone or Francistown up to **June 30, 2011** and thereafter the banknotes shall not be exchangeable and will be of no value.

The Bank urges members of the public to use this final opportunity to exchange any banknotes that may be in their possession.
