MINOR DEFECTS ON SOME NEW P100 BANKNOTES

The public is hereby informed that the Bank has discovered a minor

production defect on a small number of the new P100 banknotes.

Specifically, some banknotes have a plastic film on the hologram

which peels off together with part of the word "Botswana" on the

front of the note.

The thin transparent plastic film should have been removed by the

printers before the delivery of the notes. However, the Bank wishes

to assure members of the public that the affected banknotes remain

legal tender, and should, therefore, be accepted in the conduct of any

transaction. In the meantime, the Bank is ensuring that no defective

banknote is issued.

The public is further urged to continue to be vigilant and always

check all the features when receiving banknotes to ensure that such

banknotes are genuine.
