OLD TWO PULA COIN IN CIRCULATION

The public is hereby informed that the Bank has received numerous reports that some businesses and members of the public refuse to accept the old P2 coin in payment for goods and services alleging that the coin has been demonetised and that it is no longer legal tender. The Bank wishes to clarify that the P2 coin under reference has not been demonetised and is still legal tender. Both the old and the new P2 coins should, therefore, continue to be accepted interchangeably in settlement of commercial transactions anywhere in the country without fear.
